Operational plan

- a. Fixture scheduling
- b. Flow into and out of facility
- c. How clubs will ensure that the total number of people at the facility at any one point in time is adhered to
- d. Details of club compliance officers and flow marshals.
Multiple entry/exit points and how this relates to flow into and out of the facility
- e. Multiple venues – eg for Round robin – certain clubs and LFA have access to their own facility

Club Compliance Officers

- Roles and responsibility of COVID
- Ensuring that COVID compliance officers take ownership and responsibility at club and LFA level.
- This will require the development of an online google contract between compliance officers and SAFA Cape Town.
- This contract must outline the role and responsibility of compliance officers and the sanctions for non-adherence.
- This contract will form the basis upon which we hold compliance officers accountable.

Sanctions for non-adherence of COVID protocols

We need to clarify what sanctions should apply to clubs that are found to be non-compliant.

- This includes withdrawal of the compliance certificate
